Mother Teresa Catholic Primary School and Zuccoli Primary School utilise shared facilities including the oval, multi-purpose hall, canteen, Outside School Hours Care (OSHC), kitchen garden, home economics and music and science rooms.

The shared facilities are currently being constructed and will be completed before Term 1, 2021.

The shared facilities will allow both schools and the community to come together and fully use spaces such as the oval and multipurpose hall.

Shared user facilities have significant community wide benefit and play a vital role in nurturing healthy communities.

About the facilities

Students and families at Zuccoli Primary School and Mother Teresa Catholic Primary School will have the opportunity to access the following shared facilities:

- school oval
- OSHC
- canteen
- kitchen garden
- science room
- music room
- home economics room
- multipurpose hall.

The Principals at each school are currently working together to develop good operational protocols that will guide the everyday use of the facilities.

Catholic Education NT and the Department of Education are working together to build a robust governance framework that provides fair and equitable access to the facilities and allow the schools and wider community to have confidence in the management of the shared infrastructure and resources. This is currently being worked through and refined and the outcome will be communicated to staff in January 2021 prior to Term 1 commencing.

Details about the operational arrangements will be communicated to parents via our dedicated staff, school app and the website.

We are excited about this shared arrangement and are looking forward to seeing our students, families and the wider community come together to utilise these new spaces.
