Staying safe in the NT

All parents and visitors to the school **must** use the Territory Check In app before you enter the school grounds. This is a mandatory requirement as directed by the NT Government. Territory Check In signs have been placed at all entrances to the school.

Students are not required to check-in.

This includes if you are entering the ground for morning drop off and afternoon pick up.

Download The Territory Check In App

To download the app, follow this simple five step process:

(Internet connection and a compatible phone or tablet device is required)

- 1 Download The Territory Check In app from the [Google Play Store](#) or the [Apple App Store](#).
- 2 Register your details – this is only required the first time you log in.
- 3 Open the app at participating venues to check in. Select 'Check-In Now' and hover your smartphone over the displayed QR Code.
- 4 Add any additional people that may be with you including those without their own device or app.

When the check-in is complete, show venue staff the successful check in screen on the app.

Morning Supervision

Playground supervision will commence at 7:55am and it is encouraged that students do not arrive at school before this time. Students at school before 7:55am will be sent to Before School Care, the casual rate will be charged.

Afternoon Supervision

Students who have not been collected by 3.05pm will be sent to after school care to ensure supervision. Once your child has been signed into After School Care, the casual rate will be charged.

All enrolments at Mother Teresa are required to complete an application form for OSHC even if never used so that if needed in an emergency we can accommodate. We will be sending home forms with children whom haven't completed one in readiness for the start of Term 3.

Tuckshop

We are very excited to be starting our canteen service from Wednesday.

Tuckshop will run on Wednesday and Thursday.

Kiss and Go

Please remember the Kiss & Go zone is a short term stopping area which will enable your child to walk between your car and the school safely.

You are allowed to stop and park your vehicle for no longer than two minutes while students exit or enter the vehicle from the kerbside doors.

The zone is a designated No Parking area where you are not able to go in to the school but you may get out of your car to see your child off, within the two minute timeframe.


If you need to walk your child in or spend more time at school you must park in one of the schools car parks.
